Introduction

Churwell CIC is a social enterprise providing childcare & early education services in the Morley area of Leeds. We are based in the Japa Mill Building on the Churwell School site, Westwoodside, Morley, Leeds, LS27 9HR. Our *PLAY@Churwell* service provides a range of sessional early education and play opportunities for children aged 2-11 years. PLAY@Churwell was rated as Outstanding by Ofsted in January 2013.

Opening times

We offer sessions on Monday to Friday.

Morning and afternoon sessions are available from **9:00 to 11.45** and **12:15 to 15:00** or you can book a 6 hour session from **9am to 3pm**.

Registration, booking and fees

All children attending PLAY@Churwell Pre-school must have completed registration and consent forms – these can be downloaded from the website or call in and see us to collect one. This will help us to keep your child safe.

Morning and afternoon sessions cost **£13.75 per 2 ¼ hour session or £30 for the 6 hour session**. You can pay in advance at the beginning of each half term or pay on the day. Payment can be made by Tax Free Childcare, childcare vouchers, bank transfer, standing order, by cash or by cheque (made payable to 'Churwell CIC').

Free Early Education Entitlement for 2 year olds (FEEE)

If your child is eligible for the 15 hours FEEE for 2 year olds you can access these sessions free. Your local Children's centre will have notified eligible families. You do not have to use the full 15 hours to access free sessions.

What we can offer your child

The aim of PLAY@Churwell Pre-school is to provide a high quality, safe and caring environment that provides opportunities for stimulating play for children aged from **2 years** of age.

Our staff will provide structured play activities to enhance your child's social, emotional, physical and intellectual development in line with the Early Years Foundation Stage. Our objectives are to:

- assist in the transition to Nursery;
- assist the social and emotional development of each child;
- make social groups with a range of children;
- develop independence;
- to start the academic foundation;
- provide a safe place for the children to explore and learn;
- give each child the opportunity to learn on their own.

All children are valued and respected as individuals. We will treat each child as an individual ensuring confidentiality at all times. During activities your child will be observed and any significant observations will be added to your child's online portfolio. We encourage parents/carers to contribute to their child's portfolio.

All children will have an identified key worker who has special responsibilities for working with a small number of children, giving them the reassurance to feel safe and cared for and building relationships with their parents.

Our staff team

PLAY@Churwell and our early years service is managed on a day to day basis by our Operations Director, Michelle. Our provision is supported by early years practitioners & assistants. Our Room Leader is Kelly. Our keyworkers have relevant qualifications at Level 2 or 3 or above and have Paediatric First Aid qualifications.
